DR. K. WILLIAM KAPP

Dr. K. William Kapp, a professor of economics at the University of Basel since 1965, died April 10 of a heart attack while lecturing at the International Center for Post Graduate Studies in Dubrovnik, Yugoslavia. He was 67 years old.

Dr. Kapp had also taught at New York University, Columbia University, Wesleyan University in Middletown, Conn., and Brooklyn College. He was the author of "Social Costs of Private Enterprise," a book on the economics of ecology published in 1950.

He leaves his wife, Lore.
